BIOGRAPHY

Adrian's career began thirty-four years ago at the ABC in Australia. He spent five years with Crawford Productions and was lauded for his work on the "Stopover" MOW and won the Television Society of Australia's Award for Drama Editing on "The Far Country" mini-series.

While at Crawford's he produced and directed, over one weekend, "The Spiders," a 40 minute drama with a budget of AUS\$1,500. Adrian segued into editing Commercials and International feature films including the hits, "The Man From Snowy River," "D.A.R.Y.L.," "The Lighthorsemen" and "Quigley Down Under."

His feature film debut as director was "Now and Forever", starring Cheryl Ladd which debuted at #15 on the NY Box Office. His second outing was on the successful "The Sword of Bushido". His short film, "Permanent Stays", won the ACS Gold Award for Best Drama, and America was calling... so Adrian and his wife moved to Los Angeles.

Adrian directed the pilot and first episodes of the television phenomenon, "The Mighty Morphin Power Rangers", as well as episodes of the Warner Bros. Int'l TV series "The New Adventures of Robin Hood".

Adrian lent his talent to the burgeoning Interactive Movie arena; directing, photographing and editing the live-action portions of the CD-ROM Interactive Movie-Game, " The Pandora Directive", which won Adventure Game of the Year, and is considered by many to be one of the best computer games ever made. Adrian followed this with the sequel, "Tex Murphy Overseer".

Adrian directed John Travolta, Samuel L Jackson, Christian Slater, Anne Archer and Sarah Michelle Gellar, the voices for "A Light Knight's Odyssey", a 3-D animation film.

He also directed his first indie feature "Mind Games", starring James Wilder, Geoffrey Lewis, Richard Norton and Joe Estevez. Adrian returned to editing to cut the award winning indie "Guarding Eddy".

While writing screenplays and developing feature projects he manages to squeeze in teaching scene class at the Van Mar Academy in Hollywood.

His short film *Blood Makes Noise*, a 29 minute suspense thriller, has been doing the festival circuits, picking up an award for *Best Suspense*. Adrian has recently completed the screenplay for the feature version.

He is currently in preproduction on *Life with Oscar* starring Martin Landau, a comedy/drama feature being produced by Rosemary Marks [Thirteen] and Executive Produced by Gale Anne Hurd [Terminator trilogy/Abyss] and *Talkarra- Legend of the Boomerang*, a sci-fi adventure movie to be lensed in Australia also with Rosemary Marks and producer Michael Edgley International [*The Man From Snowy River* and *Phar Lap*].
